THE MICHAEL HURD MEMORIAL FUND



**Michael Hurd
1928-2006**

Michael Hurd was an internationally respected composer, author and broadcaster who devoted much of his time and energy to music in Petersfield and surrounding area. He was actively involved in the Petersfield Musical Festival from 1971 until his death in 2006. In recognition of his outstanding contribution to local musical life, the Petersfield Musical Festival Committee decided to establish 'The Michael Hurd Memorial Fund' to encourage and assist young musicians to create and enjoy music and so provide a lasting memorial to him.

The purpose and objective of the Fund is to encourage young people within the catchment area of the Petersfield Musical Festival to create and perform music of all kinds. Beneficiaries must be 25 years of age or under and actively engaged in studying music.

Grants may be awarded to individuals or organisations. A sponsor, who has specific knowledge of the candidate's musical experience and potential, is required to endorse all individual applications.

What kind of activities does the Fund support?

Examples of the musical activities the Fund might support include assisting with the provision of music and instruments, providing tuition or consultation lessons; supporting and encouraging the work of young composers; participating in master classes and workshops, etc.

Who can apply?

Young people of 25 years or under who have started musical training and show an aptitude in their chosen field.

How to apply?

Complete the form on pages 3 and 4 of this leaflet and send it to *The Administrator, The Michael Hurd Memorial Fund, 48 Pulens Lane, Sheet, Petersfield, Hampshire GU31 4DD.*

How much should I apply for?

Grants made will normally be between £50 and £250. Applications may be made for all or part of the total cost of the activity or project.

How are grants awarded?

The Fund's Review Panel meets quarterly to consider applications. Applicants may be asked for further information or to attend an interview or audition. Successful candidates will be notified of the Panel's decision and grant awarded. Unsuccessful candidates will be notified but no correspondence will be entered into relating to the Panel's decision.

Grants will normally be reimbursed against expenses incurred in respect of the activity or project. Evidence of these expenses will be required by the Review Panel. The recipient of an award will be required to report to the Panel, within a specified time, on the progress or outcome of the activity or project for which the grant was made.
